The struggle of a boy to save the dog he loves leads to a better understanding of the adult world.

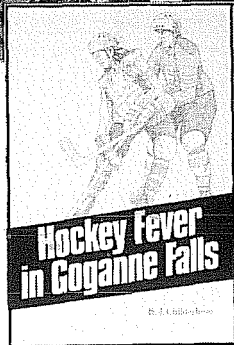
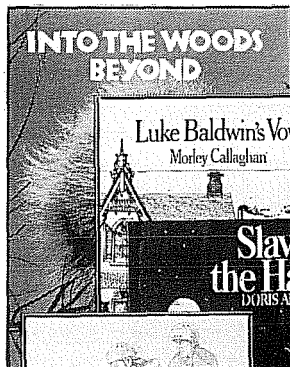
