

CANADIAN CHILDREN'S LITERATURE 1976: A BIBLIOGRAPHY

This bibliography attempts to record those books published in 1976 which are directly related to Canadian children's literature. It will be followed, in the future, by bibliographies for 1977 and subsequent years.

Our main goal has been to make the list as complete as possible. Accordingly, we have come up with a total of almost 300 items—both in French and English—for 1976. Still, though our investigations have been extensive, it is possible that errors or omissions may have arisen, especially in a few instances where we were unable for one reason or another to obtain an examination copy of a particular work. Where such oversights exist, we would be grateful if our readers would let us know so that corrections can be made in future bibliographies.

Generally speaking, the book titles are indicative of the content. In order to remove one possible source of confusion, however, those books which are neither fiction nor poetry nor drama—i.e., those books not commonly categorized as “creative writing”—have been signified by the letters “n.f.” (non-fiction) following the details of publication for the entry. Certain items for professional reading have also been included in this category.

Especially in the case of non-fiction, it may sometimes be questionable whether a particular book is more appropriate to an adult or an adolescent reader. We have tried—while still being judicious—also to be reasonably open to the range of interests and needs, often quite sophisticated, that many children and teenagers have. There is always room for disagreement, however, and we respect the opinions of others who may differ. All we can say is that the choices herein represent our best considered opinion about which borderline works are truly relevant and likely to be used by non-adult readers.

A related question concerns later editions and reprints. We have included reprints only when they involve very old books (i.e., at least 50 years should have passed since they were last published), and new editions of more recent works are eligible only when they are noticeably revised in content or when a new edition includes such extensive and distinctive artwork that the book takes on a new dimension, as does, for instance, the edition of W. O. Mitchell's *Who Has Seen the Wind* which is illustrated by the late William Kurelek. In these instances the books can be said to enter anew into our cultural life, and their inclusion in a record of one year's output of children's

literature is therefore justified.

We would like to express our appreciation to our research assistant Christie Waterston, for her assistance in checking our preliminary bibliography against those books received for deposit at the National Library. We also are very grateful to Irene Aubrey, National Children's Librarian, for her co-operation in giving us generous access to the Canadian children's collection at the National Library.
