The “Green Gables / Prince Edward Island” pot holder was made in China and was purchased at the giftshop of the Delta Prince Edward Hotel in Charlottetown in June 2008. 100% cotton, warm machine wash, gentle cycle. \$4.95. The bilingual bag of “Anne of Green Gables Chips/Croustilles” was purchased outside Moncton, NB in August 2001. Prepared by Small Fry Snack Foods (Atlantic) of Summerside, PEI. The bag claims that “our new ‘Anne Of Green Gables’ chips will appeal to those looking for an old-fashioned potato chip sliced extra thin and crunchy for a more distinctive potato taste,” and that “Anne would be proud of these great tasting potato chips due to the careful personal attention and Island love that has gone into making them.” Ingredients: specially selected P.E.I. potatoes, hydrogenated vegetable oil (Canola oil), and salt. The bag burst open when a paperweight fell on it in 2007. \$.79.
